Workshop Description:

Can we find new ways to transcend grief by way of neuroscience and the heuristics of therapeutic hypnosis? Can we make our hearts free to begin life anew after death and disappointment? Is it possible to become better than you were before? These are the questions I have asked since the death of my beloved husband and professional partner, Ernest Lawrence Rossi. In this practical workshop we will explore and experience nine Rossi therapeutic principles: (1) Living in the present moment; (2) The Biology that Underlies all of Life Processes; (3) The Novelty, Numinosum, Neurogenesis Effect; (4) The 4-Stage Creative Cycle; (5) Nature's Basic Ultradian Rhythms, including the 20-Minute Break; (6) The healing duality of the Inner Observer-Operator; (7) PsychoSocial and Cultural

Genomics; (8) Quantum Consciousness (9) The coming together of the yoga attunement of kindness, love, laughter, comfort and joy.

We will practice easy-to-learn four-stage creative patterns for problem solving as presented in *Creating Consciousness: How Therapists can Facilitate Wonder, Wisdom, Beauty, Truth & SelfCare* (Rossi & Rossi, 2012) and *The Practitioner's Guide to Mirroring Hands: A Client-Responsive Therapy that Facilitates Natural Problem-Solving and Mind-Body Healing* (Hill & Rossi, 2017) paired with ancient yoga stories and gentle movement.

Program Learning Objectives:

At the end of the program, participants will be able to:

- 1. Identify the 4-Stages of the ultradian creative cycle.
- 2. Construct a healing narrative using the 8 embodied grief dimensions.
- 3. Construct a healing narrative using the 8 limbs of yoga.
- 4. List 3 techniques of Ericksonian hypnosis consistent with modern neuroscience.

Kathryn Rossi, PhD, has edited or co-authored 20 books in the field of psychotherapy including co-editing 16 volumes of *The Collected Works of Milton H. Erickson* with Ernest Rossi and Roxanna Erickson-Klein. She has authored numerous scientific articles on psychosocial genomics and therapeutic hypnosis with Ernest Rossi along with other current topics of social and spiritual significance. She is passionate about bringing yoga into the field of psychotherapy and has taught innovative psychotherapy internationally for more than 30 years.
